





Current Notes

ILO Estimates 270m. Non-Earners by 2020

A survey by ILO statisticians of future shifts in the population structure of 33 industrialised countries in both the east and west reveals that industrialised countries will be caught in a demographic pincer as they enter the 21st century with more senior citizens in need of direct or indirect support, on the one hand, and fewer young people, on the other, to help meet this need.

Mr. Francis Blanchard, ILO director-general, says "we can expect that by the year 2020, there may be 270 million people aged 55 and over who are not in the labour force—pensioners, housewives, the handicapped". These demographic trends would mean a ratio of more than 380 such dependants of pensioners, housewives and the handicapped for every 1,000 workers. For these workers of the future it spells a responsibility almost twice that of the 1950 workforce. At that time, inactive people in their mid-fifties numbered over 85 million and the dependency ratio was 2001943: 3461,000 Mr. Blanchard says. Thus, with a foreseen increase of 185 million, the number of non-earners will have trebled during a space of 70 years.

According to ILO director-general, the problem of supporting older dependants is likely to be especially felt in Japan, where the number of non-cetive inhabitants aged 55 and over may spiral from less than five million in 1950 to over 23 million in 2020, and in Europe from 49 to 133 million. This ageing phenomemon will be compounded by the fact that the total labour force will be growing at a much slower pace and even beginning to decline. The downward trend will probably start in about 20 years and by the year 2020 more than half the countries surveyed are expected to have a smaller labour force than that of year 2000. It raises the issue that workers should be free to choose the time of retirement depending on individual capacities and interests and under conditions allowing for gradual transition form working life to one of leisure.

New Law to ensure: Workers' Safety:

The Central Government proposes to bring forward a legislation on safety of workers in building and construction industry. It is likely to cover all building construction and engineering construction workers and will include construction repair, maintenance, addition and alteration and demolition or building, furnaces, chimneys and all ancillary structures. At present, safety is being taken care of to some extent by laws framed by Municipalities and by a set of provisions incorporated in the contracts of Public Works Department, Military Engineering Services and in similar works by the State Government and port authorities. It is felt that marginal amendments in existing labour laws like Workmens' Compensation Act, Employees' State Insurance Act and Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act will not serve the purpose.























the employers and the workers group and some governments were recorded in a series of footnotes.

"Basic needs constitutes an additional variable in the general equation of development . and not an alternative strategy to that of growth," the Declaration stated. It reiterated, however, that the satisfaction of those needs was to be made "one of the highest priorities for development." Decisions on development taken in accordance with national policies concerning public, private and co-operative and other forms of enterprise should be taken in consultation with worker and employer representatives. ILO member States should ensure that they apply measures and policies contributing fully to the implementation of United Nations Resolutions concerning development and international economic co-operation. They should adopt, where appropriate, national population policies and family welfare measures.

The Conference gave the ILO a mandate to carry on its work on employment related issues, concentrating on the needs of the rural world and on the problems of poverty and low productivity in urban areas. In a special Resolution on migration, the Conference more particularly requested the ILO to carry out a comparative study of laws, regulations and practices enforced by countries employing immigrant labour.

Opposition from the employer members was recorded on specific economic matters which, in their view, "clearly fell outside the competence of the ILO."

The entire development strategy re-stated in this Resolution should, the Conference held, be brought to the attention of the United Nations General Assembly as a priority component of the new International Development strategy.

Application of Standards

Almost 50 countries from all regions of the world gave information on request to the tripartite Committee on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations concerning the discharge of their obligations under the ILO Constitution in respect of international labour standards or their compliance with Conventions they have ratified.

Many of them indicated that action would be or had been taken to ensure fuller compliance. The attention of the Conference was however drawn in a special list to 21 cases concerning 12 countries in which governments appeared to encounter serious difficulties in meeting their obligations in respect of their reports to the ILO, submission of new standards to their legislative authorities replying to observations and direct requests of the ILO's Committee of Experts on the application of Standards, or—in the case of one government—failing to respond to the tripartite committee's invitation to take part in the discussion concerning its country.

Special attention was also drawn to other cases involving seven countries. The committee reported that some of them presented serious problems and if no real progress ensued it might be necessary next year to consider listing them under the special list criterion which expresses grave concern at continued failure to implement conventions.

On the basis of a general survey carried out by the Committee of Exports, the Conference Committee also discussed a wide range of problems encountered by member States in the implementation of two of the ILO's most important human rights conventions, those dealing with the abolition of forced labour.

In adopting the committee's report, the conference noted with satisfaction the continuing efforts made by governments to ensure compliance with ratified conventions and the significant number of cases—56 involving 40 countries and territories—where changes were recorded in national law and practice in the past year following comments' by the Committee of Experts. It noted the growing use of direct contact missions by a representative of the Director-General to help countries overcome difficulties, successful results having been achieved in a remarkable number of cases.

The fact that the majority of the 202 new ratifications registered during the past year were by developing countries testified to the attachement of these countries to the ILO's standard-setting work, the conference said. The results of a recent indepth review of standards by the ILO Governing Body were widely welcomed as a valuable foundation for the Organisation's standard-setting work in the years to come. The conference underlined the importance of these activities and the need to maintain effective procedures for supervising their application.


Resolutions


Two disadvantaged groups in society—working children and disabled workers—were the subject of two of the five resolutions adopted by the conference.


The resolution concerning the International Year of the Child and the programme for elimination of child labour expresses deep concern that child labour still remains widespread in many parts of the world and that working children frequently work under conditions of exploitation detrimental to their health and welfare. It calls on States to strengthen their efforts for the elimination of child labour and the protection of children. In the transitional period pending such elimination they should regulate and humanise it, make every effort to provide educational facilities and ensure that protective legislation is applied to all children at work. It invites the ILO to reinforce its action for the elimination of child labour and for the protection of children at work.


The resolution concerning disabled persons stresses the full participation of the disabled in working life, recalling an earlier resolution recognising that all persons should have the right to benefit from vocational rehabilitation and training in order to be able to perform suitable work if they so wish. It invites the ILO to emphasise activities designed to contribute to the 1981




























Consumer Price Index Number for Working Class for June 1979

BOMBAY

344-A rise of 9 points

In June 1979, the Consumer Price Index Numbers for Working Class (New Series) for the Bombay Centre with base year January to December 1960 equal to 100 was 344 being 9 points higher than that in the preceding month. The index relates to the standard of life ascertained during the year 1958-59 family living survey at the Bombay Centre.

The index number for the food group increased by 13 points to 364 due to a rise in the average prices of arhardal, moongdal, groundnut oil, dry fish, eggs, milk, dry chillies, green chillies, onion, tea (ready-made), and sub-group index number for vegetables and fruits.

The index number for the pan, supari, tobacco etc. group increased by 14 points due to a rise in the average prices of pan-leaf, pan (ready-made) and cigarette.

The index number for the fuel and light group increased by 2 points due to a rise in the average prices of fire-wood and electric charges.

The index number for the housing remained steady at 153 being a six monthly item.

The index number for the clothing, bedding and footwear group increased by 4 points due to a rise in the average prices of dhoti, sarees, long-cloth and chappal ladies.

The index number for the miscellaneous group increased by 4 points due to a rise in the average prices of Doctors' fee, medicine, exercise books, pencil, hair oil, barber charges, tooth powder, umbrella, brass utensils, laundry charges, washing soap and tailoring charges.



In June 1979 the Consumer Price Index Number for Working Class (1960 series) for the Solapur centre with base January to December 1960 equal to 100 was 356 being 7 points higher than that in the preceeding month. 



358—A rise of 10 points

In June 1979, the Consumer Price Index Number for Working Class (New Series) for Nanded Centre with base year January to December 1961 equal to 100 was 358 being 10 points higher than that in the preceding month. The index relates to standard of life ascertained during the year 1958-59 family living survey at Nanded Centre.

The index number for the food group increased by 13 points to 380 due mainly to a rise in the average prices of turdal, gramdal, groundnut oil, beef, milk, ghee, onions, vegetables and banana.

The index number for the fuel and light group increased by 2 points to 463 due to a rise in the average price of match box.

The index number for housing remained steady at 196 being six monthly item.

The index number for the clothing and footwear group increased by 13 points to 340 due to a rise in the prices of saree and long cloth.

The index number for the miscellaneous group increased by 3 points to 295 due to a rise in the average prices of pan-leaf.
