SOLAPUR

419—A rise of 11 points

In November, 1980, the Consumer Price Index Number for Working Class (New Series) for the Solapur centre with base year January to December 1960 equal to 100 was 419 being 11 points higher than that in the preceeding month. The index relates to the standard of life ascertained during the year 1958-59 Family living survey in Solapur city.

The index number for the food group increase by 15 points to 442 due to a rise in the average prices of rice, jowar, arhaddal, gramdal, masurdal, ghee, onions, garlic, and vegetables and fruits.

The index number for the Pan Supari tobacco etc. group decrease by 1 point to 373 due to a fall in the average price of chewing tobacco only.

The index number for the fuel and light group increase by 12 points to 486 due to rise in the average price of firewood only.

The index number for the clothing bedding any footwear group increase by 9 points to 456 due to a rise in the average prices of dhoti, shirt, long cloth, markin, and trouser cloth.

The index number for the Miscellaneous group and housing remained steady at 333 & 217.

In November, the Consumer Price Index Number for working Class (New Series) for Pune Centre, with base year January to December 1961 equal to 100 was 380 being 2 points higher than that in the preceding month. The index relates to the standard of life ascertained during the year 1958-59 family living survey at Pune Centre.

The index number for the food group increased by 1 point to 424 due to a rise in the average prices of jowar, turdal, gramdal, moongdal, Oils and fats, fresh fish, eggs, potatoes, onions and brinjal.

The index number for fuel and light group remained steady at 432.

The index number for housing remained steady at 134 being a six monthly item.

The index number for the clothing and footwear group remained steady at 427.

The index number for the miscellaneous group increased by 5 points to 298 due to a rise in the average prices of laundry charges, news paper and bus fare.

THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1980**

The Employees' State Insurance Scheme applies to 34 Centres in the State of Maharashtra and provides protection to 16,20,799 workers in the event of employment injury, sickness and Maternity. This protection is made available in two ways namely by provision of medical care and cash benefits when needed. During the month of November 1980, 16,571 Insured Persons received Rs. 29,80,562.05 cash benefits due to employment injuries. This includes 41,48 persons who were in receipt of pensions for Permanent Disablement and 18,66 persons who were in receipt of Dependent Benefit as dependants of deceased Insured Persons. During the month 10,748 accidents were reported as against 11,115 during the preceding month.

Comparatively fewer persons need the employment injury benefits but a fairly large number need Cash Benefit in the event of sickness. During November 1980, 1,04,811 claims were received and an amount of Rs. 88,70,945.65 was paid out as sickness benefit. During the preceding month 1,03,714 claims were received and an amount of Rs. 88,76,921.23 was disbursed as sickness benefit.

Some insured Persons suffering from T. B., Mental, Malignant, other long term diseases etc. require more attention and they are being paid additional benefit called Extended Sickness Benefit. During the month an amount of Rs. 7,65,061.25 was paid towards this benefit.

During the month 370 Insured Women claimed Rs. 5,06,631.10 by way of Maternity Benefit. The attendance at the dispensaries as per certificates received was 3,21,677 during the month.

During the month Funeral Benefit in 124 cases amounting to Rs. 12,400.00 was paid.

During the month confinement charges in respect of wives of insured persons amounting to Rs. 76,440.00 were paid.

During the month an amount of Rs. 29,918.50 was paid as enhanced sickness benefit to 179 insured persons who had undergone sterilisation operation for family planning.

For recovery of arrears of contribution under the Scheme, Legal Proceedings had to be initiated in 88 cases against defaulting employers.
